The Provincial Directory is being updated. It was decided that the most current directory should be held by the President or Secretary of each region and that the Provincial Public Relations Officer (Mary Grace Stewart) will be responsible for updating the addresses.

The next (provincial) newsletter is scheduled for January. Any articles of ads must be submitted to Brady Leyser by Dec. 20. He particularly wants PHOTOS (black and white preferable). There is an E-Mail address for contacting Brady.

The Board voted that the OALT/ABO fact sheet and brochure should be amalgamated into a single brochure. It was also agreed to start, as a feature for the newsletter, profiles of specific library technicians.


The Board of Directors agreed that OALT/ABO will join Freenet as an information provider. This could list executive lists, job liaison information, organization profile etc.
